We were also proud to receive a **Certificate of Recognition** on behalf of the Legion at the Spaghetti Night in December. James Arnold, the Coordinator for the Blind Vets presented us with the certificate. It's posted on the board in the lounge if you'd like to take a closer look. We truly enjoy helping the veterans transition into the community as they work through the program to deal with losing their sight and continue to function on their own.














#### **Membership**
